Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board

Make counseling available for all Wood County schools

• ADAMHS Board has approved a contract with Children's Resource Center to provide therapists to Wood County schools for the 2015/2016 and 2016/2017 school year.

Survey Wood County's recovery oriented system of care (ROSC)

 ADAMHS Board surveyed healthcare providers, stakeholders, and community members to determine efficacy of system care and Wood County's current capacity to treat mental illness and addiction.

Establish a Behavioral Connections walking in clinics

Behavioral Connections is now offering walk in clinics in Bowling Green and Perrysburg. This
should assist with increasing the number of persons getting being connected to mental health
and addition services.
