

What other Community Partners are doing to improve the Health of Wood County Residents

Strategy 4: Increase Healthcare Access and Utilization

Wood County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board

Expand the capacity of psychiatric hospitalizations for Wood County residents

- ADAMHS Board is contracting with Mercy, ProMedica, Arrowhead, and Northwest Ohio Psychiatric Hospital for the 2016/2017 year.

Establish adequate capacity for providing semi-acute detox services

- Arrowhead and Zepf are being contracted with to provide services such as medications, treatment, and counseling.

Implement Net Plus

- Through a collaboration with Wood County Job and Family Services, Children's Resource Center, and Wood County ADAMHS Board, residents with severe and persistent mental illness can get transportation from their Wood County residence to any medical or behavioral health appointment.

Establish recovery housing for level 3 males

- In the summer of 2016, the Zepf Center opened the first recovery house for males in the county.

Move towards establishing recovery housing for females

- ADAMHS Board has begun discussing these plans.

Establish a recovery helpline (211)

- Hancock, Lucas, and Wood County ADAMHS Boards have developed a recovery helpline within 211. Callers are linked to the county of origin's helpline; this allows for screenings to determine best fit referral or hospitalization with Flower, Toledo, Arrowhead, and Mercy health care facilities.
