### **Resolution #FIN-07-06-2021**

Motion to approve the contracts with the Wood County Health District and the following entities to support vaccine administration.

Nilgun Sezginis made a motion to authorize Wood County Health Department to contract with any EMS agency, hospital, provider group, or pharmacy that is properly licensed and operates in Wood County for the purpose of administering COVID-19 vaccines and other medical countermeasures, pending Prosecutor's approval. Contract terms unrelated to compensation may be adjusted, pending Prosecutor's approval.

#### Compensation rates shall be the following:

 For individual administration of vaccine at a home, business or other location, \$150 per address visited;



- For Pfizer or Johnson & Johnson vaccines administered in a clinic setting, the greater of \$250 per vial or a flat fee of \$500;
- For Moderna vaccines administered in a clinic setting, the greater of \$500 per vial or a flat fee of \$500.

Contracting entities may invoice Wood County Health Department at these rates for any vaccination support provided since May 24, 2021. Compensation will be drawn from awarded federal dollars. Bob Midden seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. *Motion passed*

Motion to Approve Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Wood County Net-Plus Transportation Services.

Nilgun Sezginis made a motion to approve the MOU with Wood County Net-Plus Transportation Services between Wood County Job and Family Services, Wood County Health District, and Wood County Board of County Commissioners. The Wood County Health District's payments shall not exceed \$12,000 in a one-year period. This MOU will be in effect from July 2021 through June 30, 2022. DJ Mears seconded the motion. I. Board questions/comments to directors: Tracy Henderly informed the board she has requested an extension for the audit to mid-August.

#### **II. Health Commissioner:**

- Ben provided an update to the potential of building discussion beginning with the Health Center. Ben reminded this is HRSA funds being awarded to FQHC's for capital improvements. The Health Center's application is due June 24<sup>th</sup>. Large blue prints were provided for each board member to view where the plans have currently been discussed. Items being requested are extra exam rooms, consultation rooms, expanded pharmacy and a laundry room. This renovation would replace current office areas located in that area. This is a 3-year time line to complete this project. A brief discussion was held regarding the blue prints adding the next conversation in the future would be possible expansion to the rest of the building.
- Linda Holmes spoke on SB22 and the implications it would have on local health departments and
  their authority highlighting changes made to the bill late in the process changed language so that
  health departments can only order individuals who have been diagnosed with a disease into
  isolation or quarantine, not those exposed. Linda spoke on a couple of examples such as Ebola and
  Tuberculosis and how this bill could affect the ability for timely quarantining and disinfecting of
  establishments such as schools.
- COVID-19 Update: Wood County is about 15 cases per 100,000. June 2<sup>nd</sup> was the first day in a long time with no reported cases adding Wood County has a strong vaccine rate and July will show a slow down with clinics/events moving from managing to surveillance. This may pick up as return to school arrives. Ben added there is a shortage of behavioral resources available and Wood County is looking at how to work around this. Brief discussion was held regarding the remaining of doses of Johnson & Johnson, expiration and plans.
- Ben asked for the Board's permission to award a Public Health Day, a paid day off, on July 2<sup>nd</sup> for all staff as a thank you for all the hard work from staff toward COVID-19 emergency response for the past year.
