illness begins. Immunizations, health screenings and routine testing are all important components of preventative medicine.






### Immunizations, emotional issues, and family history

were the most frequently discussed topics during appointments.




Males aged 30-64 years old were the demographic most likely to be uninsured.




#### **Immunization**

2 Tdap stands for Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis




of Wood County Residents received their flu vaccine in the last 12 months.




More than **two-thirds** of Wood County adults over age 65 received their **pneumonia vaccine**.

- Did not have pneumonia vaccine




#### **Oral Health**

### **Health Care Access and Quality: Why It Matters**

Accessing health services is extremely important to preserve the health and wellness of Wood County residents. Keeping up-to-date on preventative medicine, including vaccinations and oral health care, is vital to preventing disease in the county population. Disparities exist between the insured and uninsured members of the community, and these disparities need to be addressed in order to create a healthier neighborhood.

Strengthening community resources that can connect residents to high-quality health care, oral health, and vaccinations is one key way to improve the health of Wood County residents, especially those that have little to no insurance coverage. Supporting legislation to fund low-cost clinics is another way to advance the health care access of the county.
