

MDRO Screening Process

1

LHD follows up with facility to determine if the case was hospitalized.

If case was hospitalized:

- Flag chart for MDRO
- If discharged, flag chart as having an MDRO history
- Place case in enhanced barrier precautions/contact precautions

LHD obtains approval from ODH to screen other patients.



3

LHD obtains approval from ODH to screen patients



- In the same room as case
- In the same hallway/area as case
- admitted to the same room post-case discharge
- For patients discharged meeting screening criteria:
 - notify receiving facility to follow-up with LHD for possible screening
 - If discharged home, flag patient's chart to prompt screening if readmitted within the next 6 months

Facility identifies patients to screen. Patients to screen should include those:

Facility completes and submits the screening request form to the LHD. The form will request the following information:

- Specimen collection address
- Test kit shipping address
- Point of contact
- Number and type of specimens

6

LHD submits the screening request form to ODH.



7

ODH confirms screening date and informs LHD.



8

LHD informs facility of screening date and test kit shipment.

9

Facility collects and ships specimens to Wisconsin (WI) lab.

10

Facility Receives Results Either from WI or LHD.

- If positive results, conduct screenings until there are two consecutive rounds (2 weeks apart) of negative results
- If negative results, no further action
